Agent Argylle is a 2020 bay gelding by Aidan O Brien's Royal Ascot winner **Mahler** who was Classic placed and Champion point-to-point sire in 2020/21/22 siring many top-class winners over jumps.

His dam **Hattie Hopkinson** is a half-sister to Monbeg Dude, the winner of the 2012 Welsh Grand National and also placed in the Aintree Grand National. He earned £260,000 in prize money.

We are delighted to offer just nine shares in this hugely promising, athletic five-year-old with great hurdle and chase potential. Purchased at the Goffs Spring Sale in May, he was recommended by bloodstock agent Gerry Hogan having won a hotly contested point-to-point at Dawstown in Ireland on 5th May, 2025. His long-term target is to compete at the Cheltenham Festival. This season we plan to enter him in the two mile National Hunt Flat races (bumpers) at **Cheltenham on 24th October** and **Ascot on 21st November 2025**.

Point-to-Point Ireland Review:

Agent Argylle who was previously seen in the Autumn when finishing fifth, put his experience to good use when running out a comfortable three length winner over Kapoutchino. This son of Mahler was given a patient ride and caught the eye when making smooth headway after the third last, he took up the running before the final fence where he made a slight mistake, he lost little in momentum and kept on strongly on the run-in for a comprehensive victory. His Dam is a half sister to Welsh Grand National winner Monbeg Dude and top hunter chaser Its On The Line. He looks a solid type that his capable of adding more winners to his tally.

Plans and Prospects for Agent Argylle

Agent Argylle is back in work after a good summer holiday that allowed him to mature well and gain great condition. His exercise program aims to build up his strength and fitness which includes some light dressage and cantering before starting faster work with the aim of having him fit to run in his first race at **Cheltenham on October 24th**.

His UK debut will be in a two mile National Hunt bumper race, which is a flat race for young jump horses in order to give them more experience of racing. Depending on how he runs at Cheltenham and **Ascot on November 21st**, we plan to start his hurdling career around the new year.

He will stay hurdling until the end of the jumps season in April and a decision on when he will progress to steeple chasing will be made then.

Costs & Benefits

Agent Argylle is syndicated into nine shares, with each share costing £5959 which includes his keep fees until 1st September, 2025. VAT is not applicable.

Thereafter monthly inclusive training fees are £300, payable by standing order, to the syndicate's Weatherbys bank account. Please see the syndicate agreement for more detailed information.

Syndicate members will receive regular updates and videos of Agent Argylle and enjoy regular visits to the gallops. He has his own Instagram account: @agentargylle123 where you can see him win the race, at Dawstown by three lengths on 5th May 2025 'very cozily' as the commentator says.

Each shareholder will receive an Owners and Trainers badge and free hospitality at the racecourse when he runs. We will endeavour to obtain extra badges for friends and family. On race days, the syndicate will have a pre-race drink and chat from the boot of the trainer's car in the Owners and Trainers car park plus a debrief after the race. You really will feel part of something special.
